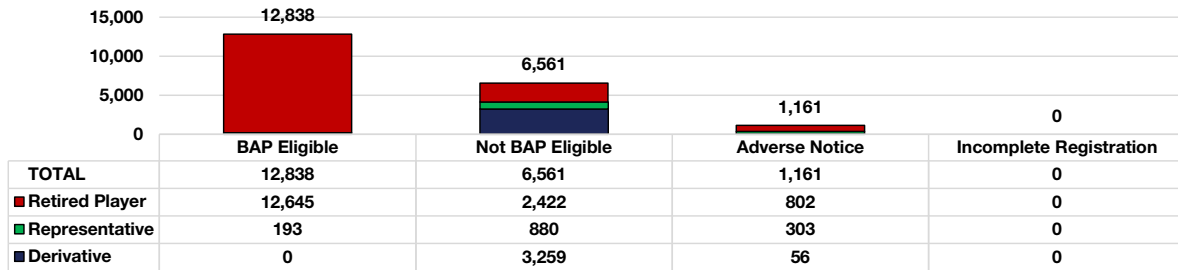

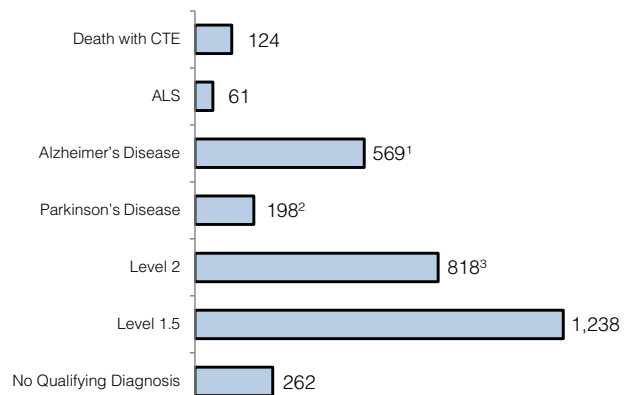

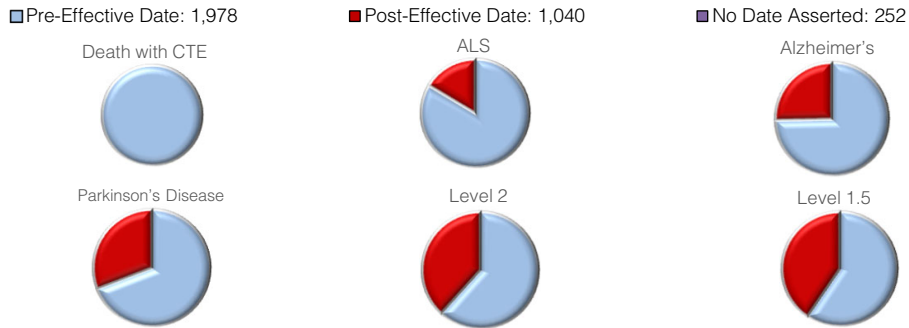

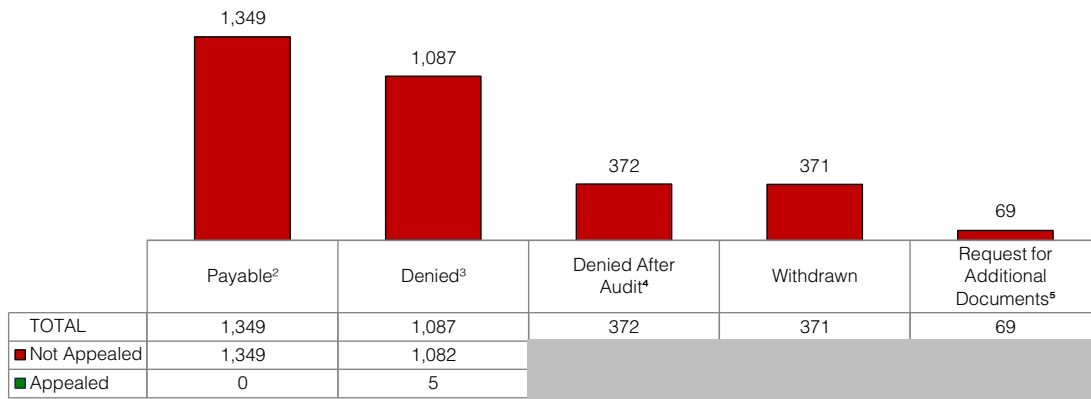

SECTION 5: QUALIFYING DIAGNOSIS DATE ASSERTED IN MONETARY AWARD CLAIMS

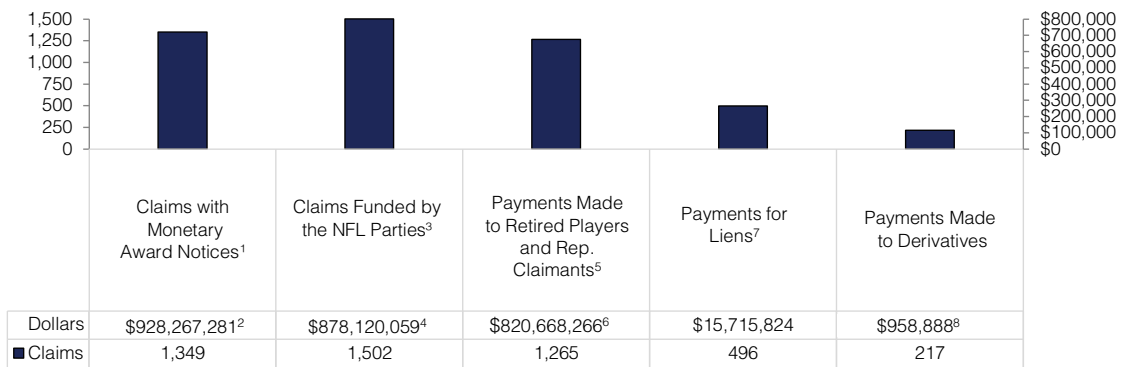
