

How to Prove Your Eligible Seasons for BAP Eligibility

Some Settlement Class Members have received Notices of Incomplete Registration indicating that we do not have information showing that they earned 0.5 or more Eligible Seasons as necessary to establish eligibility for the Baseline Assessment Program.

If you received such a Notice, send to us any game box scores, media reports, game day programs, or other documents that show you earned at least half of an Eligible Season. If you are unable to find sufficient documentation, call us at 1-855-887-3485 or email ClaimsAdministrator@NFLConcussionSettlement.com for assistance. A lawyer representing Settlement Class Members should call or email his or her Law Firm Contact.

Do not contact the NFL or a Member Club directly to ask for records. We will research the situation further and ask the NFL Parties for any records the NFL or a Member Club may have and then get back to you.

To request that we help you find employment and participation information, provide us:

1. The team(s) on which the Retired NFL Football Player played;
2. The season(s) the Retired NFL Football Player played and the number of games he played;
3. Whether the Retired NFL Football Player was on an active roster, practice/developmental/taxi squad, or injured reserve list because of a concussion or head injury; and
4. If you believe that the Retired NFL Football Player is entitled to half an Eligible Season or more for a given season, identify the season(s).

You will not receive a Notice of Adverse Registration Determination while this research is ongoing. If we are unable to obtain sufficient records through these efforts, you will be afforded additional time to provide the necessary proof.
