

Claims for Supplemental Monetary Awards

A Retired NFL Football Player (or the Representative Claimant) who was paid a Monetary Award may be eligible for a Supplemental Monetary Award if the Player later is diagnosed while living with a different Qualifying Diagnosis. The new Qualifying Diagnosis must have occurred after the Qualifying Diagnosis for which the Award was paid and the amount payable for the new Qualifying Diagnosis must be more than the Monetary Award already paid (click [here](#) to see the Monetary Award Grid amounts). If the claim qualifies, the Supplemental Monetary Award will be the difference between those amounts. See Section 6.8 of the [Settlement Agreement](#) for an example of this calculation.

To seek a Supplemental Monetary Award, a Retired NFL Football Player (or the Representative Claimant) must submit a Supplemental Claim Package containing:

- 1. A complete Supplemental Claim Form**, signed by the Player or Representative Claimant;
- 2. A complete Diagnosing Physician Certification Form**, signed by the diagnosing physician; and
- 3. Medical Records** reflecting the Player's new Qualifying Diagnosis.

Lawyers and unrepresented Settlement Class Members can submit Supplemental Claim Packages using their online portals or in hard copy:

Submission Method	Details
Portal (Lawyers)	On the Claim Package tab, click the "Eligible for Supplemental Claims" radio button to see all clients paid Awards who may submit Supplemental Claims. After selecting a Settlement Class Member, click the "Create New Supplemental Claim" button and follow the steps shown.
