Settlement Program Rules Adopted by the Special Masters

The Special Masters have adopted two additional sets of Rules for the Program:

- 1. Rules Governing the Audit of Claims: These cover the Claims Administrator's audit review of Claims for Monetary Awards, Supplemental Monetary Awards and Derivative Claimant Awards under Section 10.3 of the Settlement Agreement to determine if there has been any misrepresentation, omission, or concealment of a material fact made in connection with the claim. These Rules are available here.
- 2. Rules Governing Registration Appeals: These apply to appeals made by a Settlement Class Member or the NFL Parties under Section 4.3(a)(iv) of the Settlement Agreement from the Claims Administrator's final determination on whether someone properly and timely registered in the Program. These Rules are available here.

All Settlement Class Members and their lawyers should familiarize themselves with these Rules, which became effective on January 26, 2018. If you already have a claim in audit or a pending registration appeal, the Claims Administrator will work with you to determine how these Rules will apply to your circumstances.
